ADVOCACY FOR DISABILITY ACCESS AND INCLUSION (ADAI)

Advocacy for Disability Access and Inclusion is an independent and charitable not-for-profit organisation funded by Department of Social Services to provide advocacy support to South Australians living with disability, families and carers that support them with any kind of issue they might be facing.

What can ADAI do for me?

Who can receive disability advocacy support?

- People with disability.
- Carers and family on behalf of people with disability.

How can an advocate assist you?

- An advocate will offer you support to express your views, promote your own interests and to access services.
- An advocate will help you understand information.
- An advocate could liaise with and refer you to another service.
- An advocate can assist you to access services and resources.
- An advocate can attend meetings to support you.
- An advocate can help you with applications and letter writing.
